A study session for the Board of Directors of the Colorado City Metropolitan District will be held Tuesday, May 11, 2021 beginning at 6:05 p.m.

- 1) Resolution 07-2021 Transfer of CTF for Golf Course
 - Check from CTF was received and deposited into the general fund.
- 2) Proposal for the playground in Applewood

Two proposals were entered and added to books. It takes roughly four guys at ten hours a day for four days to assemble a playground. They are experienced and understanding of the state regulations. It will possibly take a longer time for it to be erected by CCMD personnel. \$17,000 for labor and material to outsource. Prices have increased since first discussed in 2018. Warranty offer for equipment is TBD. Mr. Elliot suggests a supervisor from the contractors to oversee our in-house employees for playground development. Mr. Collins makes a point to contact local general contractors to assemble the playground and it would perhaps be more fiscally feasible.

- 3) Community Garden with playground
 - a) Community citizen introduced a proposal for a community garden. A second citizen suggests the community garden is built alongside the playground "two birds on stone" to bring the neighborhood together. Another community citizen has concerns that a community garden developed by the person in question would not be suitable and asks the garden is not approved. Mr. Hochstetler believes it is a great idea to have a community garden but pending the exact location of playground. An estimated \$6,000 for a fence was quoted in 2018.
- 4) Resolution 06-2021 Transfer of property to greenbelt Applewood
 - a) Two lots currently owned by CCMD are still under R1 and RA motor home/mobile lots. Placement of a park would be in violation if built there. Will need approval from zoning. You cannot do anything on a lot until a house is built there. Mr. Cook asks the board to consider vacating the lots to become a part of the greenbelt for construction of the playground.
- 5) Request for using CTF funds for swing sets.
 - a) The board is agreement with the possibility to use the CTF funds toward new swing sets.
- 6) CCACC
 - a) Mr. Elliot would like to begin adding the CCACC to the study session moving forward.
 - b) Reviews from CCAAC
