RESOLUTION NO. 6-2018
RESOLUTION REGARDING FIRE HYDRANT TESTING AND REPAIRS

WHEREAS, Colorado City Metropolitan District ("District") is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado to provide residents with, among other things, water services through its water system; and

WHEREAS, the Rye Fire Protection District ("Rye Fire") is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado to provide residents with fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, Rye Fire may need to utilize hydrants on the District's water system in the event of a fire or other emergency; and

WHEREAS, the District and Rye Fire have a history of cooperating to promote public safety; and

WHEREAS, Rye Fire periodically tests the District's hydrants; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to set forth its policy regarding any repairs resulting from Rye Fire's testing of the hydrants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS THAT:

The Board hereby agrees to make any repairs to the District's hydrants or water line for damage that is the result of Rye Fire's testing of or training on the District's hydrants.

As part of the District's agreement to repair damage to the District's hydrants or water lines caused by Rye Fire's testing or training, Rye Fire has agreed to test specific District hydrants upon request outside the regular testing schedule; and, to only perform testing and training on the District's hydrants during the District's regular business hours.
